

Facilities

Our newly refitted venue boasts:

- 3 studios, with a folding partition wall between studios 1 & 2, allowing a more flexible space;
- a kitchen with tuck shop;
- toilets with baby change and a 'Little People' toilet;
- a changing room with lockers;
- video entry/exit security system;
- CDC staff & guest wifi broadband;
- Bose sound system;
- big screen projection equipment;
- Le Mark dance flooring;
- full dance safety mirrors;
- barres;
- AcroPAD inflatable floor, roller & crash mats

Terms

The first class is a **FREE** taster. You can then pay weekly for the first month before switching onto advance monthly payments via GoCardless DD

Monthly fees are calculated as:

(Weekly Fee x 40 weeks) * Divided by 12 months

In addition to the monthly class fee, there is a £2 per family, per month, admin fee payable
